




1. If a defendant has not (a) made an initial submission under the Protocol, (b) responded to the Trust's request for additional information pertaining to the defendant's Protocol submission, or (c) filed a Protocol-based motion after the Trust declined to voluntarily dismiss the defendant, and the defendant wishes to tender such a submission or response or file such a motion, as applicable, the defendant must do so by **May 26, 2026**.

2. If, after entry of this Order, a defendant receives a request from the Trust for additional information pertaining to the defendant's Protocol submission, the defendant must provide its response to the Trust **within 45 calendar days** after receiving the Trust's request.

3. If, after entry of this Order, a defendant is notified in writing by the Trust that the Trust declines to voluntarily dismiss the defendant in response to the defendant's Protocol submission, and the defendant wishes to file a Protocol-based motion, the defendant must do so **within 45 calendar days** after receiving the Trust's notification.
